APPLYING TO BE A SAIL TRAINEE AT TALL SHIPS ABERDEEN


Ready to take on the adventure of a lifetime as part of a Tall ships crew?

First, you'll need to apply and that means filling in an online form at https://bit.ly/TLLtrainee

But don't let this put you off – we've pulled together some guidance notes to talk you through and help you get on board...









Are you returning to continue your application?
Please select "ALREADY APPLIED? - LOGIN HERE"



Once you select "NEW SAIL TRAINEE PLEASE CLICK THIS LINK HERE TO APPLY", a pop-up box will appear. Please choose your method of registering.





Now it's time to complete your trainee profile to finish your registration.


Select a memorable password that you can use to log in again.


Complete the personal details section. Remember this section is about you so please use all your own details except emergency contact which would be your chosen trusted adult that would be contacted in case of emergencies.

Once complete, click the "next" button

The next part is your Address Details – enter your postcode into the box provided and click the search button


Once the search is complete, the "select your address" drop-down will appear






Once chosen, the "final address" box will appear. Check over these details, amend if there are any errors with your details and then click the "next" button

Click the down arrow on the "select your address" dropdown and choose your correct address details from the list, it will look something like this...





The next part is a few questions about yourself, so we can know you better!

For the question "secondary school attended", please enter the school you were registered at, even if you didn't attend regularly. If you are unsure which school this was, a parent or guardian may be able to help with this information

The next box is to tell us a bit more about your education, please use this to tell us about support you received during this time, any achievements or qualifications gained. Don't worry if you have nothing to add

Are you a young carer?


A young carer is someone under the age of 18 who helps to care for a family member, relative or friend. A young person aged 16-25 with caring responsibilities can be known as a young adult carer.

If you are unsure which box to tick for your condition, please see examples below that might help and then tell us how it affects you and if you have any additional information about your needs:

Deafness or partial hearing loss e.g. Deaf, Deafblind., Deafness, Hard of hearing, Hearing impaired, Profoundly deaf, Severely Deaf

Learning difficulty e.g. Dyscalculia, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia, General leaning difficulty, Global learning difficulty, Learning difficulty, Verbal dyspraxia

Autism Spectrum Disorder / Condition e.g. Autism spectrum disorder, Autism spectrum condition, Asperger's syndrome

Other developmental disorder e.g. Attention deficit disorder, Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, Emotional learning behaviour, Emotional learning difficulty, Global developmental delay, Oppositional defiant disorder

Physical disability e.g. Amputee, Hemiplegia, Carpal tunnel syndrome, Difficulty walking, Paralysis, Paraplegia, Physically disabled, Quadriplegic, Unable to walk, Uses walking stick, Wheelchair user

Mental health condition e.g. Addiction, Anxiety,, Bipolar disorder, Depression, Eating disorder, Panic attacks, Postnatal depression, Schizoaffective disorder, Schizophrenia, Seasonal affective disorder, Self harm

Long-term illness, disease, or condition e.g. Angina, Arthritis, Asthma, Cancer, Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), Dementia, Diabetes, Epilepsy, Heart condition, High blood pressure (hypertension), Multiple sclerosis, Osteoporosis, Stroke

Also to be a Trainee you must be available on the sailing dates 10 July – 2 August 2025

You will only sail in one race but will need to be available for all dates

SAILING DATES:

Are you available between the 9th of July and the 3rd of August 2025? Successful applicants will sail in either Race 2 or Race 3 of the Tall Ships Races 2025. Applicants will only sail in one race but must be available for all dates.

Race 2 on 10 July - 21 July and Race 3 on 21 July - 2 August 2025

SELF FUND / FUNDING APPLICATION:

A place on the Tall Ships Race as a Sail Trainee costs up to £2,000, which covers all transport, meals, equipment and accommodation.

You can apply for help to pay for your place with our funding programme, or you can choose to fund your own costs. Final costs will be confirmed in due course.

Taking up this once-in-a-lifetime experience should be accessible to everyone, as well as fairly distributing the set amount of funding we have.

Priority for funded places will be given to those who face the biggest financial barriers, and this is assessed during the application process.

Click to select SELF FUND if you are Self Funding and will finance the sailing place yourself or select APPLY FOR FUNDING if you would like to apply for funding to finance your place.

If you select SELF FUND, please ignore the FUNDING QUESTIONS and go straight to the bottom of the form and click REGISTER


